

Carriage for Forklift

Carriages and Carriage Parts - Rated by the blade carriage lifting capability, there are four sizings of hook type fork carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is roughly thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry cargo up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry cargo as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is 25 inches.

Pin mounted forks vary by the amount of offset between the blade and the tine eye. Some makers would differ the carriages for pin type forks. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
